Pentucket Regional School District OPM Selection Process Summary

Overview

The building committee appointed 7 members to a sub-committee for Owners Project Manager selection. Once the Request for Services was approved and posted by the MSBA the sub-committee followed the process identified in the RFS and required by the MSBA. Proposals were independently evaluated and scoring sheets were returned. This constituted 80% of the overall process with the interviews completing the final 20%. The sub-committee met to discuss the interview process and chose to interview the 3 top scoring companies and also created 7 interview questions that all companies would respond to. After interviews were conducted the sub-committee independently evaluated all 3 companies and submitted scoring sheets. The proposal and interview scores were combined which identified Vertex as the top scoring company. A reference check was conducted which revealed strong satisfaction from the schools they have worked with.

5 companies returned proposals and the 7 member sub-committee evaluated them based on the scoring criteria, see the results below.

Vertex was the highest scoring company and as a result several schools where they have done work were contacted to check their references

Jonathan Seymour spoke with 4 different school systems regarding their experience with Vertex as project manager on their building project. Haverhill

Cardinal Spellman

Vertex worked with them on a few separate projects including a new fitness center and renovation of science labs. They were great at developing creative solutions on a campus with multiple wet lands and conservation concerns. They did extensive research on environmental impact of the projects and were very knowledgeable and responsive to questions and concerns. They were very pleased with how the project came together.

Bridgewater-Raynham

Everyone I spoke with from admin assistant to Superintendent said they loved working with Vertex and Jon Lemieux. The project came in on time and under budget and was very smooth from beginning to end.
