		 The MSBA package was submitted to the MSBA on October 23, 2019, after October 22 Building Committee approval. D+W is officially beginning the Construction Documents phase working towards the 60% CD pricing set and the Early Release Package #1 on January 14, 2020. The 60% CD MSBA submission deadline is February 25, 2020. D+W asked Justin Bartholomew to sign the Design Development Completion & Construction Documents Phase Authorization letter. The Design Team expects to receive the DD Submission MSBA Review Comments within the next 3 weeks.
1.2	Record	Permitting Update:
		Conservation Committee: D+W reported that the Conservation Commission site walkthroughs with West Newbury, on October 18, and Groveland, on October 26, took place uneventfully. The ConCom Notices of Intent are scheduled to be mailed on Friday, November 1, for the November 4 th deadline. Planning Board: D+W reported that the draft Site Plan Review Applications were submitted yesterday, October 30 via the FTP site. The signed document will be posted today after the Working Group meeting when Dr. Bartholomew will sign.

More people from Groveland were in attendance than expected. Questions asked related to: Blasting; noise, pre-blasting survey of wells and buildings Demolition noise for summer and fall Noise/work hours 6:30am-3:00pm – did not seem to be an issue Will information be shared with students and parents? Yes Schedule, soft start in March, Aprils real start of CA Water run-off protection to protect River; filtration system under parking. Follow-up: water well concern during blasting. Preconstruction survey for houses and wells

		Overall, active conversation was beneficial so that concerns were addressed, and questions were answered; likely will result in less issues arising at the public hearing. Contact information was provided in case further questions arise.

	PRSD	 The swap land is registered land and there is a process that has to be gone through. D+W/WTR needs to know if the area will be available for construction use during construction. If used for laydown area materials will likely be visible above the fence. Stockpiles have low impact on neighbors. Justin stated that the group will be kept up to date.
		Greg H. said that when acquired, CA will have 2/3 of area, 1/3 is for maintenance.

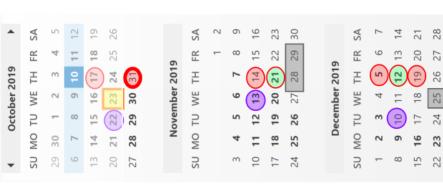
